## AGREEMENT CONDITIONS FOR THE COLLECTION OF WASTE ON BEHALF OF LOCAL VOLUNTEER GROUPS

One of Minehead Town Council's priorities is:

Working toward making Minehead a Green Town; promoting sustainable living, protection of our environment and enhancing the quality of life for our residents and visitors.

There are many local volunteer groups working in our town regularly picking up litter, clearing paths, etc.

Minehead Town Council wish to assist in this work, providing a service by collecting bagged waste and disposing of it.

## AGREEMENT CONDITIONS FOR THE COLLECTION OF WASTE

- The Volunteer group must be accepted/recognised by MTC for this collection service.
- There must be a pre agreed collection point that is acceptable to both parties.
- Normally, a minimum of a week's notice of the work starting and where the waste will be left must be given to MTC.
- Collection bags must not be overfilled.
- Dumpy bags can be provided by MTC on request.
- Collection times are to be agreed within the normal operating hours of MTC.
- MTC accepts no responsibility for any personal accidents or loss/damage to equipment and only act as a facilitator for the removal of waste.
- If the work being undertaken is not on MTC owned land, the volunteer group will need to seek permission from the landowner and may be required to provide evidence of approval.
- With the exception of minimal trimming of material which is preventing access to a footpath, we request that volunteers and groups do not engage in cutting, pruning, or removal of any tree, shrub or plant between April 1- September 1.
- Collection bags will need to be separated into the following categories; Green waste, Mixed Glass, General waste, Mixed recycling (No Glass)
- Where possible waste should be separated for recycling.
- MTC cannot support any volunteer groups who are believed to use any powered machinery/ equipment.
