# Imam al-Hujjah Hospital

In 2007, DRF started constructing a 145-bed, 8-story hospital, which is committed to



improving health and lives in the region. The surgical theater consists of 7 operation rooms, two of which specialize in cardiology and orthopedics, three general ORs, in addition to one cardiac catherization lab, and one minor surgery room in the ER. Currently IHH provides affordable medical treatment to an average of 400 patients per day, and serves a population of over 3 million people. ## Orphan Sponsorship



DRF supports over 6,000 orphans in multiple Iraqi provinces; however, there are many more that need assistance. Many children have suffered so much at a young age. DRF

#### **DRF Schools**

DRF firmly believes that education changes a society for generations. In 2007, DRF opened a school for orphans grades first through ninth with over 400 students. In 2014, as-Salihat Girls Academy opened and began educating over 200 orphans, refugees, and low income students. DRF schools would not be possible without their generous donors. In 2018 DRF opened its fourth learning center which was Imam al-Sadiq Daycare for Orphans thanks to kind support from our generous donors in Michigan.

## Refugee Assistance

Over 2 million Iraqis have been displaced. Many families have fled their homes with little to no possessions. DRF has provided families with food packages, clothes, blankets, shelter, and financial assistance.
