



Pool Maintenance Guide (Salt Water Systems - Hayward Equipment)

This quick guide helps you keep your pool clean, safe, and running efficiently.

Consistent maintenance prevents costly repairs and ensures crystal-clear water all season.

Weekly Tasks

Task	What to do
Vacuum Pool	Vacuum slowly, focusing on corners and debris-heavy areas.
Clean Baskets	Empty skimmer and pump baskets 1-2 times per week.
Check Salt System	Ensure salt is 2800 to 3200 PPM and system is producing chlorine

Monthly Tasks

Task	What to do
Deep Water Test	Perfrom full chemistry check. Complete water analysis is available at Ellis Pools
Check Salt Level	Add salt if needed. Do not overfill
Inspect Salt Cell	Check for build up - Clean only if nessessary
Super Chlorinate	Super Chlorinate monthly, or after heavy use, Run for 24 hours with cover off and nobody in pool

Cartridge Filter Maintenance

Only clean your cartridge filter when pressure rises 8-10 PSI Above normal. Over-cleaning can reduce efficier
Rince thoroughly with a hose or use cleaner if heavily soiled

Pro Tips

- Brush pool surfaces weekly to prevent algae
- Maintain proper water level (Mid-skimmer)
- Inspect equipment for leaks or unusual noise
- Increase chlorine output during hot weather or heavy use
