



## Pool Maintenance Guide (Chlorine - Hayward Equipment)

*This quick guide helps you keep your pool clean, safe, and running efficiently.  
Consistent maintenance prevents costly repairs and ensures crystal-clear water all season.*

### Weekly Tasks

<b>Task</b>	<b>What to do</b>
Vacuum Pool	Vacuum slowly, focusing on corners and debris-heavy areas.
Clean Baskets	Empty skimmer and pump baskets 1-2 times per week.
Add Chlorine	Check FCL Levels - Add chlorine to skimmers if needed as directed on pail.
Shok Pool	Shok pool as directed on the product instructions

### Monthly Tasks

<b>Task</b>	<b>What to do</b>
Deep Water Test	Perfrom full chemistry check. Complete water analysis is available at Ellis Pools
Shok Pool	Shok pool as directed on the product instructions

### Cartridge Filter Maintenance

Only clean your cartridge filter when pressure rises 8-10 PSI Above normal. Over-cleaning can reduce efficiency  
Rince thoroughly with a hose or use cleaner if heavily soiled

### Pro Tips

- Brush pool surfaces weekly to prevent algae
- Maintain proper water level (Mid-skimmer)
- Inspect equipment for leaks or unusual noise
