## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR NUCLEAR STRESS TEST**

You will be undergoing a nuclear stress test. We ask you to please observe the instructions below:

- 1. The duration of the test is approximately 1.5 to 2 hours.
- 2. Please do not eat anything 3 hours prior to the test.
- 3. However, drink as much water as you can.
- 4. Do not drink any caffeine (coffee, tea, chocolate or any kind of soft drink-no diet soda) or alcohol for at least 24 hours before your scheduled test.
- 5. Please wear loose-fitting clothing, no underwire bra, short sleeves and be sure to bring along a pair of sneakers or rubber soled shoes.
- 6. No children are allowed in the testing area.
- 7. If you are **pregnant**, believed to be pregnant or breast feeding, please notify our staff immediately. Please stay away from children under 5 years and pregnant women at least 24 hours after the test is performed.
- 8. Specials Instructions for patients with diabetes:
- ½ pill with juice and toast.

- **9.** Medication restriction: Do not take the Beta Blockers or Calcium Antagonists stated below for at least 24 hours before the test.
- **10.** Do not take Anacin or any other caffeine-coated Aspirin for at least 24 hours before the test.
