## Profile greeting examples

### Instructions...

- Write your greeting from the perspective of **what your biggest cheerleader would say** to describe you.
- Many dating site platforms have a limit on characters or word counts. Take out all the unnecessary fluff. Be as descriptive as possible, but in brief terms. **Brevity is more valuable than grammatical accuracy.**
- Shoot for something less than 350 characters(60 words or less). **Some apps limit characters to 300.**
- Remember **you're not applying for the job of wife or mother**(that will come later, after time and trust is built in). Describe yourself from the perspective of someone fun to spend time with on Friday or Saturday night.
- Many women make the mistake of using their bios to sell character traits like loyalty, good listener, nurturer, etc. Though these traits are important in the big picture, they're **less likely to land you a date on Friday night. That's the only job you're applying for** with this greeting.
- Use these examples of greetings that would help your match pick you out of a crowd and **give him plenty of conversation starters.**

### **Example 1: (335 characters, 58 words)**

### **Example 2: (199 characters, 35 words)**

Inspired by the moon. Does that make me a space geek? Chicken wing eater, chocolate pie maker. Lover of great movies and quiet trails. Favorites? Say hi if you're smart, fun and like ambitious gals.

### **Example 3: (317 characters, 49 words)**

Light-hearted spiritual gal. Recent transplant from Boston to Cali. Former ice dancer, new to snowboarding. Favorite resorts? Work in medical. Love sports if fed properly. Churro + hot dog = I cheer for your team. Traveler. Up next, Europe. Been? Impressed by spiritual men who like spicy cuisine and dynamite women.

### **Example 4: (204 characters, 38 words)**

Teacher by day, fun haver by night. Love hikes, hot springs and bike rides. You too? Church girl, looking for a good guy. You won't beat me at Pickleball or Words with Friends, but you're welcome to try.

### **Example 5: (315 characters, 59 words)**

I'm a boating babe! An outdoorsy gal who gets dirty and has fun. I clean up pretty for date nights and church every Sunday. I'm mom to three grown kids who make life great. I love travel, dogs, and 70's music. I'm looking for a hard working, gospel-oriented, guy who is committed to a happy, fun and ambitious life.

### **Example 6: (333 characters, 55 words)**

Cali girl who loves the beach and volleyball. Healthy eater, smoothie maker, fish lover. Point me to your fave fish place? Traveler. Big Sur enthusiast. Yes to live music and dancing! Work in holistic healing. Spiritual, often religious. Seeking a kind, well mannered man to love the whole me. Humor and playfulness win extra points.
