1.	All Dogs Must be on a Leash. All dogs entering and exiting our facility must be on a leash. Remember, your dog may be friendly, but we may have other dogs in our lobby that have not been assessed yet. There may also be pets present for services other than socialization. Please Initial
2.	Risks and Benefits. The safety and well-being of your pet is our first and foremost priority. All dogs that are admitted to <i>SSPP</i> are closely monitored by our staff at all times. While we take every precaution to ensure your dog's safety, you understand that there are risks associated with group socialization of dogs. Just like children at a playground, bumps and bruises may occur. Dogs have a tendency to play with their mouths and paws, and there may be times where your pet will get a nick by another dog's tooth or nail. Any injuries to your pet will be reported to you. By signing below, you agree that the benefits of group play outweigh the risks, and that you accept those risks. Please Initial
3.	Medical Care / Emergency. In the rare circumstance that a medical emergency arises while your pet is at our facility, it is imperative that we get him or her medical attention immediately.
