Her journey with PDRTA started out commuting to essentials like doctor appointments but she quickly learned the routes could take her to all the places she needed to go.


Now a regular on PDRTA's DART, HART and Society Hill Commuter routes, Ms. B rides daily. She loves

PDRTA Bus Operator Azalee McPhail, recognized Ms. B and along with six other riders, dubbed them the 'Magnificent 7'. Ms. B and this group played an instrumental role in expanding PDRTA services in Darlington County. From meetings, to petitions, to promoting PDRTA, to riding the bus, they showed up.

A mother of ten and grandmother to 30, Ms. B has traveled PDRTA often with her family too. Her grands have made the trip with her from Darlington to Florence.

Ms B. shared that over the years she has witnessed the growth and positive change PDRTA has made. She is excited for this growth to continue and said she is looking forward to the bus shelters coming to Hartsville.



Chesterfield Connects

January 29th, PDRTA alongside Chesterfield community leaders, celebrated the success and positive change of new bus routes connecting Chesterfield county at a ribbon cutting ceremony.

The new routes established are two fixed routes and one demand response, call ahead route. The fixed routes are Chesterfield Connect East and Chesterfield Connect West. The demand response route serves Cash and Patrick to Chesterfield or Cheraw.

Each Chesterfield Connect fixed route features strategic stops positioned to serve residents, providing convenient access to essential medical services, employment, educational institutions and other necessary life connections.

Chesterfield County Connect West and Chesterfield County Connect East, will run Monday, Wednesday and Friday making three round trips each day.

Cash and Patrick to Chesterfield or Cheraw Demand Response service is on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Residents in these areas will need to call ahead to PDRTA's Dispatch team at (843) 665-2227 x2 to schedule a ride at least 24 hours in advance.

Journeys to Better Health

New PDRTA Bus Route Links Lake City to MUSC Health Black River Medical Center

Beginning February 5th after a ribbon-cutting ceremony, the Florence-Lake City-MUSC Black River Commuter now provides a vital connection for Lake City residents to high-quality health care.

This commuter route has 16 strategic stops along its way. Commuting from PDRTA's Florence Transit Center to MUSC-Florence, through Coward and Scranton, connecting with LakeTran (Lake City's current bus route) at the Lake City Walmart before heading to MUSC's Black River Medical Center.

The commuter route makes four round trips daily, Monday through Friday, starting at 7am and concluding each day around 6:30pm. This commuter route is FARE FREE.

In its first month, this route has had over 200 trips and we anticipate seeing this grow as awareness continues to improve.

Thanks to the partnership with MUSC Health for making this route possible!

March 18th we celebrated Transit Driver Appreciation Day giving each driver a Subway gift card.










Pee Dee Proud!
