Briefly describe the project or purpose for which you require a Grant. . . .

The grant applied for is to cover some of the costs incurred in running the 2023 Minehead and Exmoor Music Festival.

The festival is on 24th-29th July and comprises four concerts of classical music: three orchestral concerts in the Regal Theatre and a chamber concert in the Methodist Church. The festival is a community event, with the 60+ orchestra players provided with accommodation by local residents and audience members travelling to Minehead to attend the concerts from a wide area.

In common with most such events, the festival has never been funded entirely by ticket sales. Additional income, from donations, sponsorship and grants, is required each year. After a break of two years, 2022 was a challenging year for the festival. Immediately post-Covid there was a significant drop in audience numbers combined with increased expenditure – particularly travel costs for the orchestra members – which resulted in the festival making a loss of £4000. A number of initiatives have been taken by the Society to remedy the situation for 2023: the budget for advertising the festival has been increased to restore the audience figures to their previous levels and, on the assumption that they will not quite do so in the space of one year, applying for more grants to cover the expected shortfall.

While, during the year, there are various recitals and chamber music events in West Somerset, the festival is the only time a full symphony orchestra comes to the area. 2023 will be the 60th year the festival has been held - demonstrating that there is an appetite for such music, and the Society believes that the festival helps to raise the profile of Minehead as an entertainment and cultural centre.
