



Our 2024/25 Highlights A Year of Proud Achievements

This year we:

- Won a Gold Award in Southwest in Bloom, recognising our efforts in beautifying public spaces
- Funded community bleed kits for use in emergency situations across the town
- Celebrated the Blenheim Gardens Centenary by planting a commemorative tree.
- Provided ongoing support for town-wide floral displays, contributing to community pride and aesthetics.
- Obtained a £35,000 grant fund from SALCs health and wellbeing fund to provide enhanced youth services in the town focusing on health and wellbeing. Delivered in partnership with Minehead Eye

- **EAT Festivals**: We committed funding for three events over the next three years, promoting local food and businesses
- Victorian Christmas: A joyful celebration of our heritage and local talent
- **VE Day Community Picnic**: Brought families and generations together in remembrance and unity
- Minehead Bay Festival: A vibrant, inclusive celebration of coastal culture
- Blenheim Gardens Band Concerts: A cherished summer tradition showcasing live music in a beautiful setting







Caring for Our Environment Green Actions with Long-Term Impact

- Rewilding Project: Now in its third year, this initiative has expanded into the cemetery and churchyard, improving biodiversity and creating natural habitats for local wildlife
- Weed Control Strategy: Following community feedback, we've adopted a balanced approach that addresses both environmental concerns and community aesthetics
- Sustainable Floral Displays: We continue the transition towards drought-resistant and perennial planting without compromising on visual appeal
- Recycling Points: More bins introduced across key open spaces make it easier for residents and visitors to recycle while enjoying our town"








Supporting Our Community Partnerships and Grants That Make a Difference

- **Community Grants**: £5,000 was distributed to local groups driving positive change
- Minehead Youth Services: £6,000 annual support to Minehead Eye, helping keep vital services accessible for young people
- Citizens Advice West Somerset: £5,000 contribution to sustain free, local advice services for residents in need

These partnerships are central to our mission of fostering a compassionate, connected town.

Shaping Our Future Asset & Service Devolution

- On May 1st 2025, Minehead Town Council proudly assumed management of our town's parks and open spaces.
- This transition brought experienced grounds staff from Somerset Council to our team, creating a unified workforce dedicated to Minehead's needs and ensuring consistent standards across all green spaces.
- With decision-making now at town level, residents benefit from faster response times, locally-tailored services and direct accountability ensuring these valued spaces are managed with local knowledge and community interests at heart.





Residents often face confusion about which council handles specific concerns, leading to frustration and delays. Through our recent devolution process, Minehead Town Council now manages nearly all town green spaces, simplifying this particular service area. However, clear distinctions remain between Town and Somerset Council responsibilities.
