Time Commitment: Flexible hours, evenings, and weekends, with additional

time commitment as concert performance time draws near.

This is a paid part-time salaried position.

Chorus Mission: Singing as a community for the community.

Chorus Vision: When we sing, we change who we are. When we change

who we are, we change the world.

Responsibilities:

- Perform piano accompaniment for practice, rehearsals, and performances for all MCC choruses and ensembles
- Lead section rehearsals by playing parts, identifying mistakes and problem areas, correcting mistakes and providing the right notes and rhythms.
- Assist singers in learning vocal music interpretation
- Manage music training tools (wikispace, etc.)
- Choir preparation: initial teaching of the rudiments of various pieces
- Band Arrangements: work with Artistic Director(AD) to locate and select concert musicians as necessary and assist with orchestration and coordination of band accompaniments to the chorus
- Compose arrangements as needed
- Fill in for AD during rehearsals when AD is not available.
- As the MCC organization grows, assists in developing other potential MCC choral groups
