<u>Test Results:</u> We have completed the Baseline Assessment on all grade levels. MAP is for K-2 and USA Test Prep is for 3-5. Measures of Academic Progress® (MAP®) test results. These tests determine the student's instructional level and measures academic growth throughout the school year, and from year to year in the areas of Math and Reading. MAP reports show what students know, is ready to learn, and is projected to achieve throughout the school year. MAP tests produce scores that make it possible to monitor student growth from year to year. MAP Testing is developed by NWEA based on national achievement and growth norms. Questions are based on Common Core State Standards. Students receive a RIT (Rasch unit) scale score; which offers a reliable and stable scale. Students performance can be compared to other students in the school, district, and United States.
