For the May elections, a person must be registered by April 7th to vote in the Municipal Election and April 25th to vote in the Primary Runoff. You are the difference as we prepare potential voters for the May elections!



Thoughts from PCRW VP of Legislation

Pay It Forward Leadership, Taking time to share your history by passing it on. Recently I was given a book, <u>Woodrow the White House Mouse</u>. The suggestion was to read and share with children in my area; maybe even go to the schools, or for a reading at the library.
