## **Beginner**

A beginner has little experience in construction and/or equipment operation. For beginners, installs are usally done by a VersaPile Crew but involving trainees so they might learn how to perform a proper installation. This is hands-on training to move into Experienced



### **Experienced**

For those with fundamental understanding of construction, with basic experience operating equipment. In this stage, most often VersaPile will send a single foundation expert to your community. They will ensure solid foundation installation using local skilled operators and equipment.



### **Expert**

An expert is a Certified Installer, with experience installing VersaPile foundations in their community. At this level, VersaPile typically offers occassional support over email or phone. Experts can take their skills and offer foundation contracting to nearby communities or businesses.
