- Operate excavators/skid steers and drive units to install helical piles to engineering specifications and project shop drawings
- Confirm pile locations, elevations, and installation requirements, ensuring installs meet VersaPile workmanship standards
- Lead the install flow on site: coordinate tasks, keep the crew productive, and coach Field Crew Members with dignity and care
- Work closely with clients/contractors as required and escalate risks, constraints, or site issues promptly
- Complete project documentation and reporting accurately (including plan folder review and engineer submission requirements)
- Ensure vehicles, tools, piles, and materials are organized, stocked, and staged efficiently so the crew is ready to begin the day
- Drive truck and trailer combinations to job sites, complete driver logs, and comply with carrier safety requirements
- Perform pre-use checks and required documentation, including DVIs and JHAs

Ensure COR safety standards are maintained on site and on VersaPile property

- Adhere to and champion safe working practices and procedures
- Take ownership of ensuring JHA and DVI checks are completed and documented
- Relay safety requirements and concerns that need action (PPE needs, hazards, site issues, etc.)
