



Supply List for Carolina Oneto Imaginary Places Five-Day Sewing Retreat

Fabrics

- One yard of a dark or light fabric that will work as the sky in your landscape.
- One half yard each of 10 different colors that you like. Pay attention to the color values of the 10 colors. Try to bring:
 - Three light values
 - Three dark values
 - Four medium values
- From those 10 fabrics, bring one color in three different values--light, medium, and dark.
- Six fat quarters, four of them analogous colors and the other two the same color, but different values.
- Bring four fat quarters of any fabric to use for practicing the different piecing techniques you will be learning.
- This list is the minimum amount of fabrics to bring to the retreat. If you have the ability to bring more fabrics of different colors, do so. You will have more options from which to create your project.

Notes

If you have an ipad, download the app [ProCreate](#) and bring it to the seminar. It is a fantastic tool to draw and design your quilts.

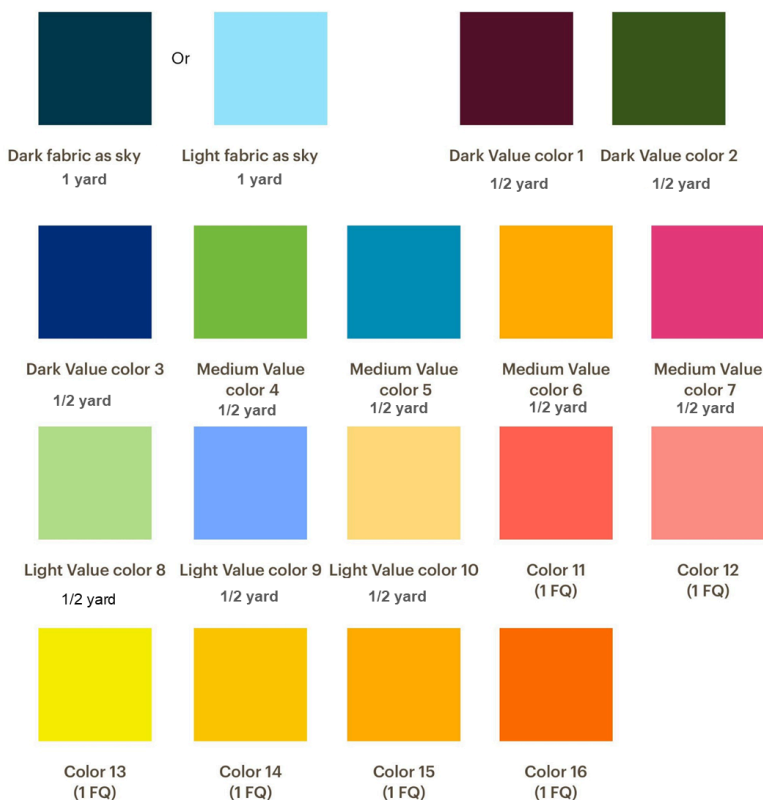
The best way to check value is using your phone camera with a black & white filter.

Sewing & Designing Items

- Masking/Painter's Tape
- Notebook for Drawing
- Colored Pencils In colors similar to your fabrics
- Washable Glue with Fine Point Applicator (It could be a Elmer's or Roxanne Glue)
- Ruler
- Paper Scissors
- Glue Stick (for Paper)
- Pins
- Fabric Marker (Erasable)
- Rotary Cutter with a New Blade
- Cutting Mat (There are also mats available from the Estelle Center to borrow.)
- Quilting Ruler 2.5" x 18" is preferable
- Double Tracer Wheel (Find it here: <https://a.co/d/eBzbFmo>)
- Neutral Colored Sewing Thread
- Roll of 15" to 18" Freezer Paper*, Minimum of 200" Length (Find it here: <https://a.co/d/0FBA7Dj>)
- Thread for sewing in a neutral color

1.- Color 2, color 4 and color 8, are the same hue in 3 different values

2.- Color 11 and color 12, are the same hue in two different values

3.- Color 13, color 14, color 15 and color 16 are are 4 analogous colors (next to each other in the chromatic circle)
