The Beaver Flat 50 (more information here) is one of Saskatchewan's and Canada's premier ultra trail running event. Prairie Sky Running Co is committed to hosting world class running events. The Beaver Flat 50 is in its 9th year. Registration sells out within 24-48 hours. It's attracts runners from Saskatchewan, across Canada and throughout the world. It is an international event. An average of 450 runners, 70 volunteers and 200 spectators converge on Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park to take on one of the best and most challenging foot races in North America.

## **Submission Requirements**

Please submit proposals to **info@pksyrunning.com** care of **Jeff Dudar** by **April 15, 2025**. Proposals should clearly address the following requirements:

- **Compliance:** Demonstrate how you will meet all public health and safety requirements, including obtaining necessary health permits.
- **Meal Service:** Provide a single, high-quality, delicious meal for all racers (**450 units**) at a reduced cost, in lieu of revenue sharing with the event host. Prairie Sky Running Co. will cover the cost of these meals.
- Food Delivery Plan: Outline how you intend to deliver food service between 10:00 AM and 7:00 PM, including your estimated arrival time (Friday night or Saturday morning).
- Dietary Options: Ensure the availability of gluten-free and vegan meal options.
- Beverage Sales: Offer a selection of non-alcoholic beverages for sale.
- Mobility and Self-Sufficiency: Operate as a mobile and self-sufficient unit no external power will be provided.
- Payment Options: Accept debit, credit, and cash for additional sales (Wi-Fi will be available).
- Appeal: Provide food that will be well-received by the event's audience: ultramarathon runners (450), volunteers (70), and spectators (200).
- Service Hours: Food services must be available from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM.
- Location: Food services are required at Saskatchewan Landing Provincial Park.
