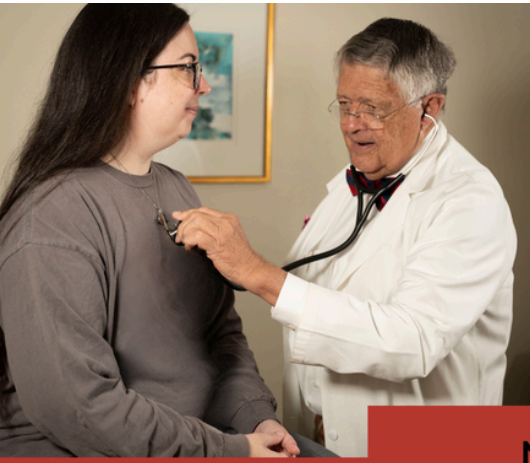

ENSURING CONTINUED ACCESS TO BREAST HEALTH SERVICES

Earlier this year, Macon Volunteer Clinic learned that the **Pink Promise United funding through a partnership with United Way and Atrium Health**—which helped cover the cost of mammography screenings for our female patients—would not be renewed. This created uncertainty about how we would continue providing these vital services at no cost to our patients.

Our **Director of Operations, Theresa Ferrari, and Care Manager, Merry Gardner**, worked diligently to find a solution and were able to establish a new agreement with Atrium Health Navicent to continue covering mammography and breast health services through another grant-supported program.

We are incredibly grateful to **Atrium Health Navicent's Breast Health Center** for their continued partnership and commitment to our patients. Because of their support, our patients can continue receiving important preventive screenings without the added worry of cost.

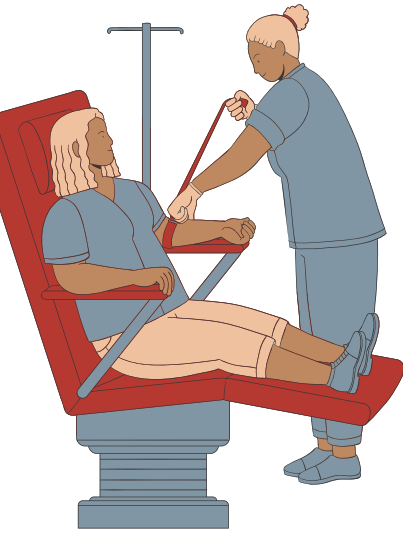
This partnership is a great example of what can happen when organizations work together to remove barriers and ensure access to essential healthcare.
