We are a small group, with a limited but expanding repertoire and two 'bookings' over the winter months, but we have no wish to remain small and new members would be assured of a warm welcome.

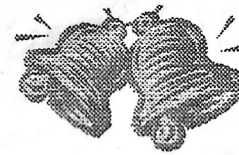
