Some Site Features

- A total capacity of 145 beds and a total area of 83,000 Sq Ft near completion.
- The surgical theater includes five main ORs in addition to minor OR, a procedure room in the IVF clinic, and a Catheterization lab in the Department of Cardiovascular Medicine.
- The ORs are composed of modular operating cells, built with powder-coated stainless steel wallboards, and furnished with Laminar Airflow system.
- A fully integrated IT system, which includes HIS and PACs systems.
