Food and In-kind Distribution

Food packages, Eid gifts, and kitchen and home appliances are distributed to low income families and orphans.

Refugee Assistance

Over 5 million Iraqis have lost their homes because of the war. Many of them are internally displaced people (IDPs). They are forced to leave their home with nothing more than the clothes on their backs. Development and Relief Foundation provides monthly assistance to refugees with a warm meal, ample clothing, safe shelter, and crucial financial aid. DRF has provided blankets to Christian refugees in Southern Iraq, along with in-kind items, such as thermoses, heaters, and swamp coolers to refugees in many camps.

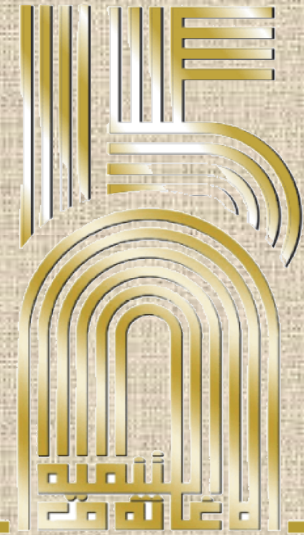

Imam Al-Hujjah Hospital in Karbala



Imam Al-Hujjah Hospital (IHH) opened its doors to patients at its out-patient clinics on May 23, 2017. It took ten years of hard work, perseverance, and over coming numerous challenges to complete the construction of the hospital and be able to provide the much-needed healthcare services to patients. In March 2018, IHH started its second stage of providing in-patient services such as emergency room situations, ICU, Obstetrics/ gynecology surgeries, angio-catheterization labs, GI departments including endo-colonoscopy units, coronary care units, radiology departments, diagnostics labs, ophthalmology departments and pediatrics departments.

The next stage will be to provide cardiovascular surgeries, starting the second half of 2019. Upon completion of all stages, IHH will be able to medically serve a population of over 4 million people with advanced medical care. IHH will also create between 600 to 900 jobs and over 300 indirect job opportunities. IHH offers free of charge or discounted healthcare services for people of low income, orphans and widows. Currently IHH treats an average of 400 patients a day.

Al Salihat Girls Academy

Al-Salihat Girls Academy opened in November 2014. A school which has the capability to educate over 400 young ladies from grade 7th to 12th. A majority of our students are orphans however there are a few exceptions of low-income advanced students which pass placement tests. We would like to thank all the donors that have made this possible.

As of September 2018, Al-Salihat Girls Academy teaches over 200 intelligent young women. Graduates of the school have been accepted at prestigious and advanced universities such as medical, pharmacy, dentistry and engineering schools. Thanks to the Khaki Foundation, DRF was able to provide student loans to as many as 15 orphans and low-income students graduate from Al-Salihat Academy with outstanding grades and get accepted to competitive majors such as pharmacy, dentistry, medicine and engineering.



DRF Schools



DRF firmly believes that education changes a society for generations. Imam al-Sadiq elementary school was established in 2007, exclusively serving orphans. Concluding its 12th year in 2019. Twenty three teachers and administrators serve an astounding four hundred boys and girls. Students study courses ranging from math, science, history, social studies, Arabic, and English, Saturday through Thursday. What makes the Development and Relief Foundation's school so special is the fact that DRF has gone beyond the required curriculum by adding computer skills and physical education courses.

Along with an elementary school we have established a kindergarten as well. With the generous contribution of the Dearborn, MI community, a preschool and kindergarten that exclusively caters to over 100 orphans was built, and has proudly started teaching these young leaders of the future as of September 2018.
