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Root Canal Post Operative Instructions

Refrain from eating for at least 2 hours and until the anesthesia has worn off to prevent possible injury to your lips and cheeks. This time interval will also allow the temporary filling to set to a reasonable hardness.

We expect your tooth to be sore to chewing and biting pressure so you should avoid very hard or chewy foods. This should gradually decrease within 7-10 days after treatment.

Be sure to take any antibiotic medication prescribed for you as it will help the area to heal.

If you have any of the following signs or symptoms please call our office as these complications do not occur routinely:

- * A reaction to the prescribed medication
- * Increasing tenderness or marked swelling in the area surrounding the tooth
- * The temporary filling completely dislodges from the tooth (it is normal for small pieces to come off)
- * The tooth fractures

A crown or other final restoration should be placed within a short time (typically within 2 1/2 weeks) interval after root canal therapy is completed unless we have advised you otherwise.
