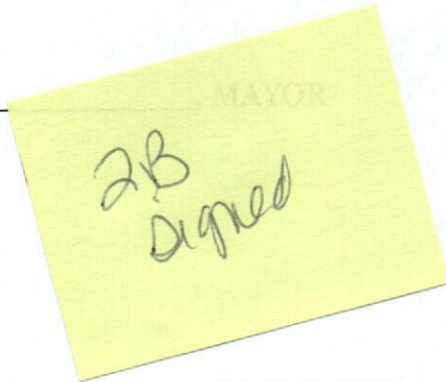



AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 200.100
REGARDING COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen for the City of Pierce City, Missouri wish to amend City Code 200.100

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PIERCE CITY,
MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: This ordinance amends Code 200.100

SECTION TWO: This previous Code 200.100 is repealed and replaced. The new Code 200.100 shall read as follows:

SECTION 200.100 COMPENSATION

A member of the Police Reserves will not be entitled to participate in any City sponsored employee benefit plan. Police Reserve pay shall not exceed that paid to any full-time Police Officer of the City. Police reserves will only work when scheduled by the Police Chief or in his absence the Mayor. Any Police Reserve for the City shall be subject to the same rules, regulations and ordinances which apply to full-time Police Officers of the City.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance supersedes and revokes any provisions of past ordinance(s) inconsistent with the provision of this ordinance.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage and approval.

SECTION FIVE: Said approval being effective the 14th day of October 2024
