This drawing was done by Charlene in grade 11 when she was 17 years old.

She had not received medication and the anxiety reactions were so intense and frequent that counseling and cognitive behavioral therapy was not effective. She missed a lot of school as documented on her attendance record for that year Two band aids are across her mouth and she has the word **LIFE** written on them and she is trying to contain the pain and confusion inside and maybe it'll go away-just maybe.

Trauma destroys the trust relationship of the victim with themselves and the world.

This creates an inordinate amount of stress on the mental, emotional and physical capacities of the victim whose coping behaviours and belief structures have been shattered by trauma.

The victim no longer knows how to act or what to expect from the world in order to survive.

The victim develops characteristic symptoms described as post-traumatic stress disorder.
