Dear Dr. Farthing:

Further to my telephone message to you, I have decided to document an incident with Charlene last night for your ongoing assessment and consideration.

June 07, 2000 As a family we decided to go to Swiss Chalet for supper. Wednesdays are specials and sometimes we go there. When we got there I noticed Charlene was a bit agitated/hyper and she did not know where she wanted to sit but soon made-up her mind. She colored and seemed happy. Chuck & I had our usual quarter chicken breast with the wing, and the children had the children's chicken strips, their usual.

At the end of the meal the waitress brought the Treasure Chest for the children to pick a toy. this time there were a few new things, one being a black mask which would go over the eyes. She wanted the mask and we encouraged her to take another toy, saying masks are out right now as halloween is over. She insisted to keep it, but as we were ready to go she changed her mind and put the mask back in the Treasue Chest and took out the same toy as Jonathan had, a toy airplane.

From there we went to the Garden Center at Canadian Tire and looked at the flowers and bought some plants.

Upon getting home I called my oldest son to speak with him. At one point my daughter-in-law put our granddaughter who is 11 months on the telephone for her to hear me talk to her. Charlene wanted to talk to her and so she did for a minute. Then Charlene went off to bed.

About 10 minutes later Charlene comes into the kitchen crying. I was speaking to my son and stopped to check what was the matter. She said she had an ear ache and I told her that she didn't have a fever, but that grandpa would give her some Tylenol. Chuck proceeded to get the Tylenol and went to give it to her and she began screaming. At that point I got off the telephone and went to her bedroom and she was saying she did not want Tylenol but ear drops. I told her we did not have any but she could take the Tylenol ((it is an elixer and for children). She refused on the basis it is yucky but I offered her a drink of juice with it, as this is what she has done in the past. She shook her head 'no' and was extremely upset.

I left her bedroom and told her that if she changed her mind and wanted tylenol I would come back. The intensity of the screaming increased and I returned to her bedroom and she was on the floor sobbing and screaming loudly and on her knees rocking back and forth. I tried to comfort her and encouraged her to stop crying and she said "I can't." She was soon able to get out between her sobbing, "Mommy I'm having a really bad feeling!" I encouraged her to verbalize what it was and she said.

Charlene: I'm thinking about mommy and the rest of them killing the babies.

Me: What are you remembering?

Charlene: How they killed the babies.

Me: How did they do it - what do you remember?

Charlene: I remember how they killed them -how they cut their arms and legs off and put them in a pile, and it grossed us out.

Me: Are you telling me that they cut the arms and legs off the baby?

Charlene: No, not right off just part way.

Me: Charlene I don't understand how they did that.

Charlene: (now completely calmed down and relating her memories of these happenings) - " I'll show you with my Snugglies." She reaches over to her toy box that is near her and takes out three soft toys /bears.

Charlene proceeds to demonstrate and explain to me what happened.

They put the baby down like this and she puts the bear in a supine position and then they cut here and here (uses her finger as a knife and cuts in the axillary and groin areas, doing first the arms and then the legs. After she does this, she says as to correct herself, "No, grandma, they do it like this. There are two tables one next to the other. Each of them takes a turn at killing a baby.

Me: Who is there?

Charlene: Mommy, Daddy, Auntie ~~Victoria~~ Uncle Victor, Danka and Nik.

Me: Were there others there other than them?

Charlene: No, not then, just all of them and me and my cousins.

Me: Did they wear anything special.

Charlene: Well they wore their masks over their faces - they were different colors.

Me: You said there are two tables Charlene, why two?

Charlene: Well one of them, say it was Auntie ~~Victoria~~ turn to kill a baby, this is what she's do. She would take the baby out of a box, when it was sleeping and put it on the table. Then she would turn the baby over (Charlene demonstrates with her teddy bear putting it in a prone position. Then she would cut the arms and legs. Just like this. (she shows me).

She didn't cut the arms and legs right off just part way.

Me: Was the baby already dead?

Charlene: No, not yet?

Me: Did the baby make any noise?

Charlene: Yes, the baby was screaming.

Me: What happened next?

Charlene: Then Auntie ~~Victoria~~ would take her knife and stick it into the baby's back. (Again she demonstrates with her teddy bear.

Charlene continues: Then they turn the baby on its back and stab it in the heart.

Me: Is there a lot of blood?

Charlene: Yes, lots!

Me: Why are there two tables?

Charlene: Well after Auntie ~~Victoria~~ does that or whoever has killed the baby, then it is shoved down to the next table (and she demonstrates by saying this is the other table and pushes her teddy bear along the floor.

Charlene continues: Now, one of them, say it is mommy, she will come to the baby and check it over to be sure that it is dead. If the baby is dead they push it onto the floor. Then someone else will kill another baby in the same way, and another one checks to see if it is dead.

Me: Do they kill more than one baby at a time?

Charlene: Yes, they each kill one.

Me: Where would they get these babies?

Charlene: I don't know. Uncle Victor leaves in a taxi and comes back with the baby or sometimes, mommy tells me that they are babysitting and then they kill other people's babies.

Me: Are you certain they were babies? Maybe they used dolls that looked like babies and that had red liquid in them, or used chickens?

Charlene: No, they were real babies - I know they were.

Me: How many babies were killed at once?

Charlene: Four or five - not more than ten at a time.

Me: That is a lot of babies. Where did they keep them?

Charlene: They were beside them in a box and they were all sleeping.

Me: Charlene, do you remember telling Dr. Clay that they cut the baby into pieces and cooked some of the pieces and made you eat it?

Charlene: Yes, but they only did that with some, not all of them. After that we had to eat some of the pieces. The cousins and I put the pieces of the baby in garbage bags and buried them in the back of auntie Victoria's backyard. The cousins and I would smooth the dirt over them (and she demonstrates on the floor, as though she is doing it) and then we put flowers on top, but daddy always took them away.

Me: Charlene I noticed when you first came to live with us that you had a hard time when we went to Swiss Chalet but other times lately you have been OK. Does going to Swiss Chalet bother you sometimes.

Charlene: Yes!

Me: Do you know why?

Charlene: Yes, its the meat!

Me: Why the meat?

Charlene: It makes me remember the babies.

Me: This has been very awful for you Charlene. Grandpa and I are so sorry this happened to you.

Charlene: I am really, really bad on the inside.

Me: Bad? -do you mean sad?

Charlene: Bad is sad.

I asked her to just tell grandpa some of what she told me and we would go in the livingroom. She brought her three teddies and went over the story for him. I then gave her a drink of juice and the Tylenol and settled her into bed.

It appears to me that Charlene is retrieving more memories. She also stole money from us a couple of days ago and lied about it again.

As I thought about what the triggers may have been for her to recall these memories I noted four possible ones, and they are: the cooked meat/chicken at Swiss Chalet (the smells, and the part where we tear or cut the wing off), secondly, the mask, thirdly, the flowers we went and saw, and fourthly, talking to her cousin (baby) on the phone.

With disclosures and incidents ongoing like this I really have to question the wisdom of supervised access for the children with their mother. As Dr. Matthews put it that contact could re-activate the already damaged psyche. That damaged psyche is still in a healing process, and should not be jeopardized in my opinion. Using the children to motivate positive change in Melinda, is not in Charlene's best interests at this time. Chuck and I would appreciate professional psychological support for ourselves and for Charlene in particular.

Dear Dr. Farthing:

I left a message after receiving yours, but thought I would follow it up with this fax,

I am unsure if there is a telephone where she is staying at. But you would be able to speak with her at the Salvation Army at tel: # (306) 757-1631, The woman who oversees the visits is Edith,

I will be taking Leslie there tomorrow and I can let her know that you may call her.

I would like to help Des but do not know what to do. She is still with Dillen Tell. In asking her questions you will likely get the answer that she thinks you want to hear. If it is appropriate you could relay to her that I will help her to get out of what she is in, yet I know that it is not that simple.

I want to let you know of an incident this morning with Charlene. Last night on her way to bed she knew that Leslie was going to have her visit on Friday and that it had been cancelled for the usual time which was yesterday. I asked her again (as I had not for a few months, if she would like to visit her mom. This time she said that she would because she never gets to see her. I told her that we would wait to hear from you before deciding.

This morning she was looking for a library book that her teacher asked her to bring back and the teacher was asking all the children to return their books before school ends. Anyway she could not find it and she began crying saying she wasn't going to school and we tried to get her out the door telling her we would look for it tonight and it was alright that she did not have it and her teacher would not be angry. She refused to go and Jonathan had the bus driver holding the bus for her and Chuck ran out in his slippers and housecoat to wave the bus to go. Charlene was sitting on the floor and distraught. I sent her to her room and after a few minutes went to talk with her and reason with her but that seemed in vain. I asked her if there was anything else bothering her as she was too upset I thought for simply not finding this library book. She mentioned about the television show about the tornado that I had mentioned to you in my fax to you yesterday. She said, "Grandma I'm thinking about that girl in the show where the tornado broke the window and she was thrown backwards and lying there dead with all the blood on her face. -it reminded me of the babies cause that's how they would look dead with blood all over them." I comforted her and I called the teacher and then took her to school. She still received a grounding for not dealing with the library book situation and refusing to go to school.

I thought I would let you know this as this is a current situation which do not happen too often now but when they do are very troubling. It seems obvious to me that she is still affected from the past trauma, and this is why I still have reservations of her seeing her mother. I think of what Dr. Matthews said in his report that visitation for her should not occur in her developmental years as it would only serve to re-activate the already damaged psyche, and that appears to have validity even though I would like to see the two of them visit, I know that we can not decide that this should occur if there is a chance of reactivating the already damaged psyche..

This is why it is so important that Charlene is not put in the position of deciding this and that it is the experts in the field that need to. I hope there is a consensus between most if not all of you on the matter.

Dear Dr. Farthing:

Thank-you for the telephone call yesterday. I am sending the additional info out to you by Puralator. I could not do it as planned yesterday as i had your address at my home and not at the office.

Dr. Hatfield has referred Charlene to Dr. Matthews on an urgent basis, as he believes that Charlene will need medication, and has always believed that Charlene should not see her mom for a long time, considering the abuse she had endured and the problems that could arise if they did resume.

The fact that you endorsed the visitations and have not filed your report has apparently changed his direction in referring and communicating with you. I did indicate to Dr. Hatfield that you told me that you would drag your heels on this as you and I knew what had happened here, but that they (the cult members) are bigger than us and in a court of law they would win, not chuck and I. I told him that your dragging things out was purposeful and that this apparently would make it more likely that the children would stay with us, as Social Services were not supportive of us and had formed rather negative opinions of us.

The Principal at Athabasca school said that he is asking Charlene's teacher this year and the one last year write a report on how she was as a student. I have enclosed a copy of her report card from last year.

Charlene has been progressively getting worse and has not attended school since Thursday, September 19, 2002. Other areas include the following:

- She has been having what appears to be panic attacks and during these spells she complains of having headaches and feeling 'weird'.
- She also gets nauseated, sometimes heaves in the toilet but does not throw-up
- During the attacks she also experiences varying physical symptoms, mostly cramps and pain in her pubic / vaginal area and will hold herself and jumps up and down

holding herself.

- While she is in this state she often will complain of one of her legs hurting, particularly the lower part of her leg (calf) and points to the ankle aching, paining her as well.
- Her appetite is affected and the teachers have noted that she has not eaten her lunch and has discarded it. Chuck and I have witnessed the same, where she packs the food in her cheek and goes to the garbage or bathroom to discard it. She insists on packing her lunch and is picky about what she packs and eats, and then very often does not eat what she packs. Charlene can be in this state periodically or for a couple of days at a time.
- She claims she feels OK if she is outside, but doesn't like it inside the school. This is almost like claustrophobia.
- She panics when we go to restaurants and will not eat and begins to build-up into an anxiety state requesting we get home right away.
- Food triggers reactions - more foods all the time.
- The CES-D Children's Rating Scale was at 41/60 and was done yesterday. Charlene is severely depressed according to the answers she gave me.
- She says she feels scared and not safe as someone is coming to get her - particularly as she believes that he is really mad at mommy and us and that he is so bad that he'll hurt us all.
- She does not want to be separated from me, and gets hysterical if I press her to go to school. We have sent her earlier last week and she comes 'undone' there and calls me to get her right away.
- I have to lay with her again every night (even though her sister Leshe is with her in the bed) or she will not fall asleep and in fact will get so anxious that she has an anxiety attack.
- About twice per week she is waking in the night, crying and saying she doesn't want to go back to bed.
- She leaves for school being just fine, and then she tells us that she begins to feel weird on the bus. Again I am wondering if it is the fact that she is confined there and worries who will get on the bus. Shortly after being in school in the morning she calls home sobbing and pleading with me to come and get her.
- She is missing out on activities that she has in the past loved. She missed her swimming which she loves and is not able to go to a birthday sleepover Friday Sept. 27th because she is afraid to.
- I tried to bribe her (positive conditioning) with a reward of money per day for the next seven days she attends school and is able to hang in there. She can call me but she must 'get control' and stay the entire day. She refused to.
- We saw the Principal in the Foodcourt in our downtown mall today and spoke with him. She told him she would be coming to school tomorrow and get money for it. So we will see how that goes tomorrow.

A Psychologist and Social Worker who work with the Department of Education are going to be involved with Charlene but at this point I am not certain to what extent or how that will be. I refuse to have her go to Child and Youth Services and I have told them that.

I believe that Des needs to get help and even if it is not available in Saskatchewan, the diagnosis

This is a follow-up to the material I sent you by Purolator and the enclosed information which would have been a fax to you dated September 24, 2002, but received by yourself as only a hardcopy.

I have spoken with my lawyer on the matter of your visit with Charlene this Saturday and he believes that it should go as planned. I would suggest that you meet with Charlene if you would still like to at my downtown office at #203-1808 Smith Street as I will be counselling in the afternoon and Charlene will be with me, watching TV.

I apologize for any inconvenience but as you can imagine we are on continued stress over this matter and the disturbing regression and troubling behaviour of Charlene.

Charlene went to school and managed fine on Wednesday and Thursday but had spells in the evening. I told her I would give her a loonie for each day she could manage to stay in school as she was missing for four days in a row and we can not get to see Dr. Matthews until after the 15th of October sometime as he is away.

More details of this disclosure have come to light and Arlene Biske the Social Worker did not attempt to follow-up again after ^{my daughter-in-law's} ~~my daughter-in-law's~~ last call to her. The alledged killing of the baby took place only two years ago and not 10 years ago as Arlene told the foster mom of ~~Leshe, Joy~~. they appear that they do not want to follow this up either.

I will make a report to the police today of what i do know and we'll see if that goes anywhere.

Both the Principal and Laurel from her session with Charlene, on Friday 10, 2003, received from her the exact details as to what I received. Neither could conclude if she saw a person there or not. Mr. Jorgenson said the account was nearly identical to the second account she had provided him.

This week-end she has had two spells re: bad feelings and being more aggressive with her two siblings, telling them she hates them and does not love them, coming to me crying that she is having bad feelings again. Those are the only incidents of apparent regression that we have observed so far.

Des's youngest brother (my son) saw *Des* in the 711 store January 12th, this past Sunday morning at 9:30am. She was looking at the candy section and she did not have the baby with her. Her brother chose not to go and speak to her and left.

After *Des*'s visit on December 17, 2002, Chuck offered *Des* to bring over her Christmas gifts on December 24, '02 and offered to provide her with a visit with *Leslie* and Jonathan, but she turned it down, stating that she may see them over Christmas at her older brother's place. After lunch on Christmas Eve Chuck took her gifts by and the lady that supervises the visits (Janice) at Sophia House where Social Services put her up, took Chuck to her apartment to set them inside her place.

Des had not been invited over to her brother's nor did she attempt a phone call. She has not attempted to set-up another visit with *Leslie* and so Chuck called Janice to ask if *Des* wanted to resume the visitation every two weeks and Janice told Chuck that she would speak to *Des* and see what she wanted to do, and that she would get back to him today. Janice did not call today.

For *Des* to be in a 711 on a Sunday early in the morning, without her baby and that far from her apartment, makes me wonder what is going on! I may have mentioned to you before that was seen downtown with the baby with *Dem* in the fall.

When you finish your report for the court, please send me a copy to my home address . . . Forget Street, Regina, Sk., ~~56-777~~. I believe I instructed you to send it to my lawyer, but I will read it and then decide from there how I will proceed.

I am providing you with a copy via fax of Dr. Matthews report dated December 10, 2002 and a follow-up letter he did for myself re: his response to my question to him (after having received his report) around the authenticity / reliability of a young child's account of her abuse-that is would she (Charlene) know who her Abuser(s) were, and would she know what happened to her and /or how it happened to her and so on.

What is interesting to note is that Dr. Matthews makes the claim that "*on the whole, I tend to believe children, particularly when we are dealing to something very close to the event*".

That is also my position and that of Laurel Phillips, (Reg. Psychologist) Charlene's Counsellor.

I have requested Laurel to do a brief report for my records by mid-February, 2003. charlene has been doing very well again and is back to normal. There was one set-back on January 09, 2002. Early that evening i was going to the car with Charlene and Jonathan and Charlene insisted she sit beside me in the front seat. Jonathan reminded her that it was his turn and I agreed that it was his turn. She began to cry and scream uncontrollably and a craft she had made and was proud of and taking home to take to school she destroyed it. In the back seat she was bawling and saying she was having a bad feeling and that she was mad that nobody believes her.

As this was processed she told me that he was there again today - at lunchtime. She reported that he was standing staring at her over the fence as she played wall ball. she said it was after lunch and there were no teachers outside yet as they were still cleaning-up in the lunch room. I asked her if it was the same person and she thought it was but said that it was cold and windy and he was staring at her and she went into school. She said that she would have gone and told her Principal but he was not there that day, and her teacher was home walking her dog. She said she made sure that she did not go out for recess in the afternoon, in case he was still there. She did go from not seeing him as good due to the wind, to being absolutely (100% sure) that it was her dad and the same man with the long braid.

The following are excerpts of the documentation grandma forwarded to Dr. G. Farthing in Saskatoon, SK. She was trying to keep him informed as to my progress or lack thereof. After supervised access I apparently had flashbacks and nightmares and grandma refused to continue to take me for visits.

Both the Principal and Laurel from her session with Charlene, on Friday 10, 2003, received from her the exact details as to what I received. Neither could conclude if she saw a person there or not. Mr. Jorgenson said the account was nearly identical to the second account she had provided him.

This week-end she has had two spells re: bad feelings and being more aggressive with her two siblings, telling them she hates them and does not love them, coming to me crying that she is having bad feelings again. Those are the only incidents of apparent regression that we have observed so far.

Des's youngest brother (my son) saw Des in the 711 store January 12th, this past Sunday morning at 9:30am. She was looking at the candy section and she did not have the baby with her. Her brother chose not to go and speak to her and left.

After Des's visit on December 17, 2002, Chuck offered Des to bring over her Christmas gifts on December 24, '02 and offered to provide her with a visit with Leslie and Jonathan, but she turned it down, stating that she may see them over Christmas at her older brother's place. After lunch on Christmas Eve Chuck took her gifts by and the lady that supervises the visits (Janice) at Sophia House where Social Services put her up, took Chuck to her apartment to set them inside her place.

Des had not been invited over to her brother's nor did she attempt a phone call. She has not attempted to set-up another visit with Leslie and so Chuck called Janice to ask if Des wanted to resume the visitation every two weeks and Janice told Chuck that she would speak to Des and see what she wanted to do, and that she would get back to him today. Janice did not call today.

For Des to be in a 711 on a Sunday early in the morning, without her baby and that far from her apartment, makes me wonder what is going on! I may have mentioned to you before that was seen downtown with the baby with Damien in the fall.

When you finish your report for the court, please send me a copy to my home address . . . Forget Street, Regina, Sk., ~~244-7775~~. I believe I instructed you to send it to my lawyer, but I will read it and then decide from there how I will proceed.
