CHILD & FAMILY MEDICAL SERVICES CLINIC CONSULTATION REPORT

Jonathan Dobson is an 8-month-old child who was brought into the Child & Family Medical Services Clinic by his grandparents, Chuck and Arlene Lowery. He was also accompanied by Debbie Ferguson from the Regina Police Service. Jonathan's older sister Charlene had reported to the grandmother that her mother had been putting a spoon into Jonathan's anus. She said that her mother had also tied Jonathan at wrists and ankles. Jonathan is now in the care of his maternal grandparents and has been apprehended. Jonathan is generally healthy and development seems normal. He occasionally has some hard bowel movements. He has a bowel movement daily.

On examination, he is a large, well nourished child, who is smiling and responsive. Examination of the head and neck was normal. Chest was clear. Heart sounds were normal. Abdominal examination was normal. External genitalia were normal. Testes were down in the scrotum. On rectal examination, there was some white scarring at the 12 o'clock in the rectum. Rectal sphincter tone was actually relatively normal. Swabs were done for gonorrhoea, Chlamydia, trichomonas and GAS.

Scarring in this location would be considered an abnormal finding and is suggestive of abuse.
