## SOCIAL WORK CONSULTATION REPORT

REFERRAL: Referral was made on Jonathan Dobson, an 8-month-old, aboriginal male, received from Charlene Thurbide from DSS on April 8, 1997. The child was seen in the Child & Family Medical Services Clinic on April 14, 1997 and was accompanied by his grandmother and grandfather and his 4-year-old sister. The attending physician was Dr. Carol Norman. An interview was conducted with the grandmother and the police officer, Debbie Ferguson and the following information received.

PRESENTING PROBLEM: The alleged abuse was reported by Jonathan's 4-year-old sister, Charlene Dobson and it states that the perpetrator was their mother, DESTINY Dobson, aged 26. This happened at their apartment at 3040 Robinson Street in Regina. Charlene, aged 4, disclosed that her mother put a spoon up Jonathan's bum and he also was tied up in the past. At the time of the abuse, Jonathan lived with their mother, Charlene Dobson and common-law spouse, Destiny continues to live in the apartment on Robinson Street and it is unknown whether she lives alone. She is known to have NIK alcohol and drug abuse and reported to suffer from multiple personality disorder. Furthermore, there are allegations of cult involvement and satanic rituals. The Police and Social Services are very much aware of : Destiny and of her past and present incidents. (See other reports). Presently, Jonathan is living with his maternal grandparents and a home study is being completed to determine whether their home is suitable for custody purposes. The grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Lowery, are very attentive and will continue to be fully involved. I would recommend that the perpetrators have only supervised access and there are protection concerns. This information will be sent to the city police, to Charlene Thurbide at DSS and Jonathan's name will be placed on SCAN. I encourage that the reader of this also be mindful that Charlene Dobson, aged 4, is a victim of abuse and that Johnathan and Charlene's case is being reviewed together.
