CONSULTATION REPORT

REASON FOR CONSULTATION: Possible sexual abuse.

Charlene was seen at the ER by Dr. R. Avram who referred Charlene. She has a past history of being sexually abused and this was previously investigated. She was previously examined by Dr. C. Norman. There is an on-going investigation at present with regard to one of the mother's boyfriends, named [redacted].

Today the maternal grandmother, name Arlene Lowery, picked her up from her mother's house and she found her already dressed and ready to go in the driveway. She disclosed over the lunch hour that the daddy's name is *Dillon* *Tellus*, who is the biological father, made her touch his penis and that he also laid on top of her and made boom boom on her tummy. She also disclosed that she hates it when her mother rubs her back and her tummy and also discloses that daddy makes her sit on his lap rubbing her back.

Past medical history is unremarkable. She has been on no medication.

On examination, she was alert. When I asked her about what had happened, she started telling me about dad made her touch his penis and that she regrets quite noticeably and started talking quite gibberish and baby talk, but whereas previously she was quite verbal and had a good concept of language. There were no rashes. She had some healed impetigo over the ankles. The cardiovascular, respiratory, CNS were normal. There was no abnormality of ear, nose and throat examination. Examination of her genital area revealed some mild erythema over her labia majora. There was no bruising noted and no laceration noted. The posterior fourchette was intact and the hymen was also intact and crescentic in shape. It measured about 0.5 cm across. The fossa navicularis was also normal and the anus was normal with no bruising or any anal fissures.

Swabs were taken for gonococcal and chlamydia. From the clinical examination I could find no abnormality except for mild erythema, but the disclosures are very concerning and the maternal grandmother and Charlene were seen by Family Mobile who have made arrangements for Charlene to stay with the maternal grandmother until the investigation proceeds on Monday.

~~It is very suspicious of child sex abuse~~ from the disclosures, although the clinical examination appears to be normal.
