Consider the experience and credentials of the school's faculty. You want to learn from experienced facilitators who are "practicing what they are preaching" and who can guide you through the learning process.

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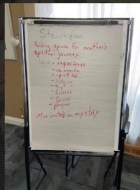
Program Format

Look for a school with a good reputation. Check reviews and ask for referrals from current and former students to get a better sense of the school's reputation.



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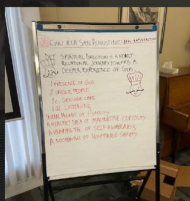
Flexibility
