

The importance of spaying & neutering your cats

DID YOU KNOW?

Unless spayed, an adult female cat can have kittens...and her kittens can have kittens. A female kitten can become pregnant as early as 4 1/2 months of age and a male kitten can impregnate a fertile young female at the same young age. Be responsible, have your cat spayed or neutered for their health and well being.



ALL IN THE NUMBERS!

An unspayed cat can produce up to 3 litters per year. With an average litter size ranging from 4 - 6 kittens, a single unspayed female and her offspring can produce more than 400,000 cats in their lifetime.





HEALTH BENEFITS

Your female pet will live a longer and healthier life. Spaying helps prevent uterine infections and breast tumors which are malignant or cancerous in about 90 percent of cats. Neutering your male pets prevents testicular cancer and some prostate problems.



MYTHS VS FACTS:

- 1. Myth:** It causes laziness and obesity. **Fact:** Not enough exercise and over eating causes weight gain and decreased energy.
- 2. Myth:** My pet is too young. **Fact:** Most cats can be fixed between 6 and 9 months, talk to your vet and see what they recommend.



- 3. Myth:** It's painful. **Fact:** Your pet is given anesthesia by a trained professional and is not awake during surgery. There may be some discomfort afterwards, but most animals recover quickly.

- 4. Myth:** It's best for pets to have one litter first. **Fact:** There is no scientific evidence that points to any benefits of letting your pet have one litter before being spayed.
