

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF WOODEN TUBS AND BATHS

Our wooden bathtubs offer an extraordinary and unique bathing experience.  
To ensure they serve you well for a long time, there are a few rules you should follow.

### 1. Surface treatment

- The wood is dried to approx. **9% moisture** content and glued together.
- The surface is treated with **Complex Hartolwasch oil – Austria**.
- We recommend repainting **approximately every 1–2 years**. However, it is advisable to consult us beforehand – **we will assess the current condition of the bathtub** and recommend whether repainting is really necessary.

### 2. Use and bath

- **Do not use large amounts** of bath salts – they damage the surface coating.
- If you use **soap or shampoo**, it is necessary to **rinse** the tub with lukewarm **water after bathing** and wipe it with a cloth.
- If water remains in the **bathtub after draining**, it must be wiped up as soon as possible – at the latest by the end of the day.
- We recommend ventilating the **room after each bath**.
- If the bathtub is equipped with a backrest, **remove it after bathing**.
- You can make relaxation even more enjoyable by adding herbs to your bath, for example from Květomluva. ( kvetomluva.cz )

### 3. Cleaning

- Most suitable product: **Wellness Cleaner** (also available from us).
- **Procedure - once every 14 days:**
  1. After emptying, spray onto the surface.
  2. Leave on for about **10 minutes**.
  3. Rinse with **lukewarm water**.
  4. The bathtub can be refilled immediately.
- Use when dirty and as a **preventive measure**.
- **Do not use cleaning agents containing chlorine**.

### 4. Location and storage

- Do not expose to **direct sunlight**. If you have underfloor heating, please consult us in advance.
- When placed outdoors, we recommend **covering it with a cover or tarpaulin**.
- In winter, it is necessary to **prevent water from freezing** to avoid damage to the bottom. It is best to add salt to the tub.
- If the bathtub is **not used** for a long period of time (**more than 1 month**) and the room temperature is above 18 °C, place a **bucket of water inside** and cover the bathtub with foil to maintain the necessary moisture content of the wood.

### 5. Maintenance

- Tighten the **fastening screws when dry**.
- Regularly check the sanitary **silicone around the bottom** – replenish it if necessary.

### 6. Final recommendation

When used and maintained correctly, our wooden bathtubs and tubs will bring joy, comfort, and **relaxation to the whole family**.
