

Best Dog Daycare & Training Business 2024 - Calgary

Cleaned twice a day, each room is filled with toys, tunnels, and plenty of water, ensuring that the pups have everything they need. Outside, the Dogs Tail yard is the second biggest in the Calgary area, consisting of 1,740 square feet split into three yards that can be accessed from each playroom. This outdoor space is equipped with high-quality artificial turf that mimics real grass, creating a natural and comfortable surface for dogs to enjoy.

No matter their needs, every pet is guaranteed to receive the best standard of care at Dogs Tail. With the passionate belief that all dogs deserve to experience joy, comfort, and care when their owner is busy, the business caters to all kinds of pups, from lower energy seniors to boisterous teenagers. The business aims to create a safe haven for all, providing them with a secure and loving environment in which they can thrive, be happy, and truly live their best lives.

Dogs Tail's offerings are perfect for owners who need daycare services due to their busy schedule but are hesitant or anxious about leaving their dog with a stranger. Since the pandemic, reports have shown a dramatic increase in the number of dogs with problematic behaviours. This has unfortunately led to many behaviour-related euthanasia cases. To address this significant problem, Dogs Tail works with reactive dogs, focusing on structure, mental stimulation, and slow exposure.


Unlike traditional daycare providers that offer their services based on a pass or fail meet and greet session, Dogs Tail operates on a spectrum. The business provides opportunities for dogs that struggle in social situations, helping them to work on their anxieties and aggression. In this, the goal is for them to eventually be able to join open play with the other pups.

To determine each dog's needs, Dogs Tail evaluates them based on various factors, including interactions with people, response to handling, greeting new dogs, body language, and play energy. In many cases, reactivity stems from a lack of confidence. For this reason, Dogs Tail's trainers focus on helping dogs to build socialising and problem-solving skills by exposing them to new experiences and mentally stimulating tasks. With this approach, the root cause of reactivity is addressed, creating a happier and more confident dog.

Over the years, Dogs Tail's work has led to the successful integration of many previously reactive dogs into the daycare rooms, even those who were told that they would never be able to play with other dogs. The business has also saved several pups from behaviour-based euthanasia, as well as having rehomed many dogs to provide them with the second chance they deserve.

Dogs Tail understands that reactive dogs are often banned from grooming services at other facilities. Sometimes, it is recommended that they receive vet sedation in order to be groomed. Specialising in grooming dogs with grooming anxiety, Dogs Tail creates customised slow exposure programmes, keeping them relaxed throughout the process. By providing them with positive experiences, the business transforms aggressive dogs into pups that are excited to visit the groomer. Ultimately, this reduces the number of dogs who need anxiety medication during grooming sessions.

Moreover, Dogs Tail offers a unique boarding experience that is perfect for dogs who experience separation anxiety. The service takes place at a trainer's residence, providing pups with a break from the stimulating daycare environment so that they can enjoy

a comfortable place to rest. During overnight stays, the groups of dogs are smaller, meaning each pup will receive one-on-one care, time cosying up on a couch, and other 'just like home' options. A balance between fun and relaxation is important in a dog's life, improving their mood and overall wellbeing as well as reducing their homesickness.

Overall, it is clear that Dogs Tail is passionate about its work, aiming to not only provide owners with outstanding daycare services but also play a role in enhancing the lives of dogs in need. For its continued excellence in everything it does, the company has been awarded the title of Best Dog Daycare & Training Business, Calgary, in the Canadian Business Awards 2024.

In the future, Dogs Tail aims to establish a full-scale shelter for dogs that have been given up and require rehabilitation.
